The positions that we require filling on the day include Course Marshals and Start/Finish stewards. This year we are also looking for a volunteer to take over the race start marshal role — you will be provided with a shadow day of our current race start marshal. In addition, we are also on the hunt for a relay section leader who will be in charge of assisting relay runners to their stations.

Getting behind the Standard Chartered Jersey Marathon in this manner also provides a great opportunity to soak up the atmosphere of one of the largest community events Jersey's sporting calendar has to offer.
